

Class of 2019 Graduation FAQs

1. When are caps and gowns distributed?
 - Tuesday, June 4 beginning at 2:00 in the dining hall.
 - Remember all your financial and material obligations are due prior to receiving your cap and gown.

2. Where is the ceremony located?
 - Mr. McGowan will make the call that week - probably Wednesday.
 - If the ceremony is indoors, each graduate will get 7 tickets for entrance to the gymnasium and 3 tickets for the auditorium where ceremony will be streamed.
 - If the ceremony is outside, tickets will not be needed.

3. Is there handicap parking? What about seating?
 - Yes, in the assigned area by the **Dining Hall or at the SAU building** depending on the location.
 - If held outside, the first rows of the bleachers will be reserved for those who prefer to not climb steps - there is a ramp to the bleachers.
 - If held inside, there will be a designated area for seating.

4. Is there transportation between the parking lots and the ceremony location?
 - **Yes, golf carts will be available for that purpose beginning at 4:30PM.**

5. What should I bring as an audience member?
 - Camera
 - If outside - sunscreen, bug spray, and a blanket to make the metal benches a bit more comfortable.
