Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2024,

We are happy to inform you that we will be doing a modified in-person version of our Fresh Start program on Monday, August 24th or Tuesday, August 25th. This program will include meeting administration and limited staff, a tour of the building, a senior student panel, and Chromebook pick-up.

To ensure the safety of students and staff, we will be having small groups (30 max) for a 45-minute period on either day. All students and parents/guardians entering the campus are required to wear a face covering over nose and mouth (medical or cloth, non-vented face-covering) and maintain at least 6 ft. of distance between everyone at all times. Upon arrival, you must hand in the completed clearance attestation form attached to this letter. No student will be allowed to participate in the activities without this completed form. Based on the NH COVID guidance, most activities will take place outside under a tent. Please dress accordingly for the weather.

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Winnacunnet High School Fresh Start Clearance Attestation

By attending the Winnacunnet High School Fresh Start Program you hereby attest that you:

- Are not feeling sick
- Are not exhibiting any of the following symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell), and
- Have not potentially been exposed to someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19. A potential exposure means having household contact or having close contact (within 6 feet) with an individual with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time (over 15 minutes) while the person is symptomatic or 48 hours before symptoms developed.

If you are at higher risk for more severe illness (underlying health conditions) we encourage you not to attend.
